Clean-up activity in Chío, Guía de Isora.

Departure from Santa Cruz at 15:30 h. Finish at 23:00 h

Exhibition of “Herdsman's Leap”, during the trail. It’s a traditional sport practiced in Tenerife: Canarian aborigines herding animals leapt with great skill and agility to cross the ravines and steep slopes on the island. Today, this practice is only used for sport and fun.

After de path clean up, there is a stargazing activity in Chio at 21:30 h. Tenerife is a perfect destination for this activity, as it is a Starlight Destination.
