<div data-bbox="284 734 437 891" data-label="Image"> </div> <p data-bbox="229 936 475 965">Keep your distance</p>	<p data-bbox="544 723 667 752">Entrance: There will be signage on the floor. We ask you to respect it.</p> <p data-bbox="544 819 743 848">Welcome Desk: Please keep your distance to those in front and behind you when you register on site. The minimum distance is 1.50 m. There will be appropriate signage on the floor. We kindly ask you to observe it.</p> <p data-bbox="544 987 759 1016">Welcome coffee: Please keep sufficient distance during the welcome coffee in the two lobbies (north & south). The sections with names beginning A to L go to foyer "north", those with names beginning M to Z to foyer "south". Please pay attention to the corresponding signage. The welcome desk will be happy to show you the way to the two lobbies.</p> <p data-bbox="544 1227 772 1256">Hall organisation: In order to comply with the distance rules correctly and to ensure sufficient distance between each other, theatre seating was arranged. This means that no tables can be provided this year. We thank you for your understanding. Water bottles of 0.5l are available at the entrance. On your chair you will also find a gift offered by our partner CSS Insurance.</p> <p data-bbox="544 1464 703 1494">Microphone: A microphone is provided for those participants who wish to speak. It will be cleaned before and after each use. A person wearing gloves ensures that everything is done properly.</p> <p data-bbox="544 1632 635 1662">Lunch: Exceptionally this year, lunch will be served at tables. There is enough space reserved for this in the restaurant Henris on the ground floor (refer to signs). This is necessary to comply with the distance rules. Lunch [starter, main course (meat or vegetarian) and dessert] will be served.</p> <p data-bbox="544 1834 762 1863">End of the event: We kindly ask you to keep your distance also at the end of the assembly. A quiet exit from the hall with sufficient distance to other people is to be respected.</p>

 <p>Wash your hands thoroughly</p>	<p>We provide enough disinfectant in many places and recommend that you use it regularly. Washing your hands thoroughly is possible in the restrooms.</p>
 <p>Wear a mask recommendation</p>	<p>It is not compulsory to wear a hygiene mask. However, it is strongly recommended that people at risk wear one or when it is not possible to keep the distance required. We provide masks at the welcome desk.</p>
 <p>No shaking hands</p>	<p>We recommend to avoid both shaking hands and hugging.</p>
 <p>Cough and sneeze</p>	<p>Cough or sneeze into a paper tissue or into the crook of your elbow. Wash your hands afterwards. Please throw the used paper tissue into a bin after use.</p>
 <p>Contact tracing</p>	<p>We compile a comprehensive list of all participants in the assembly. If for some reason you are unable to attend, please contact Eveline JeanRichard at the Administrative Secretariate, telephone 031 370 18 32.</p>
 <p>Isolate and quarantine</p>	<p>If you do not feel well on the day of the assembly and suspect having been infected with the COVID-19 virus, please stay at home and also contact Eveline JeanRichard on 031 370 18 32.</p> <p>Please also contact Eveline JeanRichard if you test positive for the virus immediately after the assembly.</p>
